Black Swamp open speed show rules.

- 1. No Checks
- 2. Points will be rewarded as such. 1st-10pts, 2nd-8pts, 3rd-7pts, 4th-6pts, 5th-5pts, 6th-4pts,7th-3pts,8th-2pts,9th-1pts,
- 3. All ties for awards will be broken by the number of 1st place finishes in event, if not able to break tie, then the number of 1st and 2nd place finishes and so on there after until the tie is broken.
- 4. Jackpot classes do not count towards daily or year-end awards. Points collected for daily or year-end awards are from the division classes based on, one rider/one horse/one division.
- 5. All youth 18 and under are required to wear a helmet.
- 6. Boots, long pants, shirts with sleeves and helmets are required for youth 18 and younger. Adults Can wear clothing that suitable for youth eyes.
- 7. Division age is by your age as of Jan 1st of this year.
- 8. Stallions are not to be shown in the youth, 19 and over stallions may be shown.
- 9. If your horse is outside the state of Ohio, you will need to have a negative coggins test and present it at time of registration.
- 10. Unsportsmanlike conduct, curly to animals or exhibitors, animals or exhibitors deemed too dangerous, or out of control, or excessive rail coaching, are all grounds for dismal by the Black Swamp open show committee.
- 11. Any unsound/unhealthy animals will be excused from the show ring and potentially the grounds.
- 12. Any tack changes must be requested at entry booth at least one class prior.
- 13. Black Swamp Open show committee decisions are finial.
- 14. No refunds
